## What to bring to FAFSA Night (appointment required):

***NOTE: You and your parent(s) must apply for PIN numbers at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). Please bring these numbers with you to your appointment.***

- Driver's license and Social Security number of student
- W-2 forms and other records of income earned in 2009 (student and parents, or spouse if student is married)
- 2009 income tax return (student and parents, or spouse if student is married)
- If applicable, both parents' Social Security numbers and dates of birth.
- Record of untaxed income (Social Security benefits, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, Welfare, VA Benefits)
- Value of bank accounts (checking and savings accounts), investments, business and farm assets
